- A. Machine-specific system machine operator rosters shall be established for the following machine and categories of machines:

2. CAT 09s
3. Rubber Tired Cranes (such as Grove/Gallion/Pettibones)
4. Tie Inserters and Removers (such as TKOs/TRIPPs/TR-10s)
5. Combination Cribber/Adzers


The following machines will be removed from the machine-specific system operator rosters:

6. 6700s
7. Stabilizers
8. Spike Drivers
9. Ballast regulators
10. Anchor Machines
11. Double Brooms
12. Backhoes
13. Rail Heaters
14. Spike Reclaimers
15. Tie Handlers
16. Spike Pullers

The above notwithstanding, employees who bid to any of the machines identified above as 6 - 16, on any System Production Team, who have never actually been assigned by bulletin and qualified on that piece of machinery whether on a Seniority District, SLWT, SPG or other type of Maintenance of Way force will not be allowed to bid off of that position for a period of six (6) months but may be displaced by a senior qualified employee in the exercise of their seniority.
